

Villa Menara is a property originally designed as a small country villa. It was built by and served as residence of famous Moroccan architect Elie Mouyal. Recently acquired by a French couple, Villa Menara has been transformed it into a luxury family villa of 7 bedrooms.

It is nestled in the heart of a large park in the palm grove of Marrakech, 15 minutes from the city center.

Villa Menara is a charming escape with several courtyards, garden areas and terraces offering plenty of lounge space and intimate corners. A seguia (small irrigation canal) runs quietly in the vast garden bursting with flowers, fruit trees and colors.
